The 21<sup>st</sup> century has already introduced complex new priorities and challenges for the benefit of all humanity, regardless of differences in political conviction, race, faith, gender, geography, or economic condition. These emerging new values all focus on well-being and protection of the biosphere that all of us share as one community. The guiding principles of the evolving ethics include participation, partnership, economic and social equity, the conservation of resources, and the use of technology for the benefit of the environment and humanity. There is universal consensus on the need to work together towards a sustainable future for our built and natural environments.

Pluralism –in the most genuine sense– is a key factor and objective in the future world, a world where differences will no longer be the source of animosity or conflict, but instead will be valued as the essential ingredient for global and natural harmony. The architectural profession has a preponderant role and responsibility in this effort, and architecture itself is no longer seen merely as a fine art, but as a discipline to enable the bridge between technology and social and economic needs through design and the appropriate use of resources. Even within the concept of globalisation, the recognition of local conditions – and differing values and priorities – will require architects to focus more than ever before on the provision and improvement of the environments in which people everywhere carry out their own lives.

The importance of pluralism in our world has served to guide preparations for the XXII World Congress of the International Union of Architects, to be held during July 2005 in Istanbul, Turkey. The congress theme – **Grand Bazaar of Architecture S** – was chosen to give voice to each and every notable expression of all those responsible for and involved in the shaping of our environments. It will constitute a mosaic of colours, shapes, and movement that reflects the contemporary concerns of architects and others. The structure of the congress will permit every person, action group, company, client, supplier, artist, and architect to present their ideas and to share their accomplishments with the rest of the world. Within the congress theme, we also plan to **Celebrate Our Cities**, to reinforce the notion of plurality and the interaction of humankind together.

On behalf of the International Union of Architects, it is a great pleasure for me to invite all architects, students, clients, decision-makers, industrialists, hardware and software companies, community leaders, and concerned individuals and institutions to join us during July 2005 in Istanbul, where architects and other professionals will come together and interact as the focal point for the celebration of World Architecture.



21-üncü yüzyılın zaten karmaşık yeni öncelikler ve zorluklar için tüm insanlık için fayda sağlamak amacıyla, siyasi inanç, ırk, din, cinsiyet, coğrafya veya ekonomik durum farklarına bakılmaksızın, tüm insanlığın paylaştığı biyosferin korunması ve iyileştirilmesi üzerine odaklanmıştır. Evrensel bir konsensus, teknolojiyi çevre ve insanlık için fayda sağlamak amacıyla kullanmak, katılım, ortaklık, ekonomik ve sosyal eşitlik, kaynakların korunması ve teknolojinin çevre ve insanlık için fayda sağlamak amacıyla kullanılması gibi yeni değerlerin ortaya çıkmasıyla birlikte, gelecekteki etik ilkelerinin değiştiği görülmektedir. Evrensel bir konsensus, teknolojiyi çevre ve insanlık için fayda sağlamak amacıyla kullanmak, katılım, ortaklık, ekonomik ve sosyal eşitlik, kaynakların korunması ve teknolojinin çevre ve insanlık için fayda sağlamak amacıyla kullanılması gibi yeni değerlerin ortaya çıkmasıyla birlikte, gelecekteki etik ilkelerinin değiştiği görülmektedir.

Pluralizm –en gerçek anlamıyla– gelecekteki dünyada, farklılıkların artık düşmanlık veya çatışmanın kaynağı değil, küresel ve doğal harmoninin temel bileşeni olarak değerlendirileceği bir dünyadır. Mimarlık mesleği bu çaba için öncelikli rol ve sorumluluk taşımaktadır ve mimarlık artık sadece bir sanat değil, teknoloji ve sosyal ve ekonomik ihtiyaçlar arasında köprü kurmak için tasarım ve kaynakların uygun kullanımı disiplini haline gelmiştir. Küreselleşme kavramı içinde bile, yerel koşulların – ve farklı değerler ve öncelikler – mimarların her zamankinden daha fazla insanların yaşadıkları ortamların sağlanması ve iyileştirilmesine odaklanmalarını gerektirecektir.

Pluralizmin dünyamızdaki önemi, XXII Dünya Mimarlar Birliği Kongresi için hazırlanmalarını yönlendirmiştir. Kongre Temmuz 2005'te İstanbul, Türkiye'de yapılacaktır. Kongre teması – **Grand Bazaar of Architecture S** – her ve her türlü ifadeyi temsil etmesi için seçilmiştir. Bu, renklerin, şekillerin ve hareketin bir mozaiği olacaktır ve mimarların ve diğerlerinin çağdaş endişelerini yansıtır. Kongrenin yapısı, her kişiye, hareket grubuna, şirkete, müşteriye, tedarikçiye, sanatçıya ve mimara fikirlerini sunmalarını ve bunları dünya ile paylaşmalarını imkân verecektir. Kongre teması içinde, **Celebrate Our Cities** planları, çoğulculuğun ve insanlığın etkileşiminin pekiştirilmesini amaçlamaktadır.

International Union of Architects tarafından, tüm mimarlar, öğrenciler, müşteriler, karar vericiler, endüstriciler, donanım ve yazılım şirketleri, toplum liderleri ve ilgililen bireyler ve kurumlar için, Temmuz 2005'te İstanbul'da bir araya gelmelerini ve diğer profesyonellerle birlikte Dünya Mimarlık Festivali'nin odak noktası olarak kutlanmasını rica ederim.

## PREPARATIONS FOR THE ACADEMIC PROGRAMME OF THE UIA 2005 CONGRESS

Preparations for the XXII Congress of the International Union of Architects (UIA) to take place in Istanbul in 2005 are under way. The host country members of the Scientific Committee have worked out a draft proposal for the Congress theme.<sup>1</sup> The Scientific Committee has later acquired its final form with the participation of further members, one from each of the five UIA regions. The Congress academic programme will be finalized and announced by the end of February 2004.

When competing with candidate cities during the Beijing Congress in 1999, the Chamber of Architects of Turkey (CAT) had presented the working title of the 2005 Istanbul Congress as “Life-Culture-Quality: Living with Our Past in the 21st century”<sup>2</sup> Toward the 2002 Berlin Congress, a ‘Scientific Platform’ was established to develop the Congress theme.<sup>3</sup> The Platform devised the following principles: First, the theme should reflect the values that the UIA and the CAT exalt; i.e. it should hint at humanistic ideals as well as social and environmental responsibilities. Second, the theme should be an all-embracing concept to comprise the UIA agendas concerning architectural culture and profession, ranging from issues of urbanism and cultural heritage to construction industry and architectural education. Third, the theme should expand the field of architectural knowledge, thought and action; besides its breadth for the professional field, it should spare room for interdisciplinary and intra-institutional connections of architecture.

In the preparation of the proposal, “Grand Bazaar” appeared to the editorial committee as a most prolific metaphor voiced during the Platform meetings.<sup>4</sup> It would provide a thematic structure to the Congress activities, and a basis to discuss architecture in relation to the universal culture of bazaars / markets –a relation that is so natural and yet equally tense and contradictory for the profession. The metaphor accommodates both positive and negative associations: while plurality,

festivity, competition in solidarity, and unity in diversity are aspects to emulate; the counterpart points to commodification, commercialisation and fierce consumerism as aspects to avoid. The collective willpower of architects in contributing to the welfare of people, and for a world where cultural and bio-diversity can be sustained, is the core of the theme. To this end, the catchphrase of the Congress became “Will-Wisdom-Wit”, while its acronym “www” merged with the intent of forming a network among world architects.

At the UIA Council meeting in Curitiba in November 2002, the Congress theme presented in the Berlin Congress was found rather abstract. The current programme of President Jamie Lerner, the “Celebration of Cities”, raised expectations for the theme to concentrate more on the city. The revised theme and draft academic programme presented to the Council in June 2003, Istanbul, still maintained its focus on the global responsibilities of world architects, but under the working title “Cities of Our World: The Grand Bazaar of Architecture”.

The ‘bazaar structure’ of the Congress will be realised in the charming ‘Congress Valley’ of Istanbul, with advanced communication technologies to enhance the expected aura. The aim is to create a lively and pluralist environment, a medium for creative interaction whereby architecture becomes visible in its public appearance. The international competition for the Congress logo held on the Internet this year, formed a preliminary test of the diversity intended. The competition resulted in encouraging statistics: During the 3 months of the competition, there were over 260 000 visits to its web site, and 790 logos were submitted from 53 countries. This ‘paperless’ competition was planned as a pilot study for the promotion of the Congress via the possibilities of the Internet. There is a tendency to implement a similar organisation for the UIA Student Competition of the 2005 Congress.

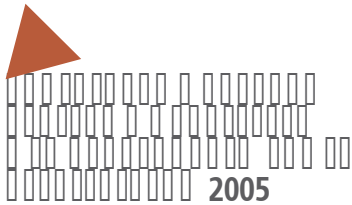

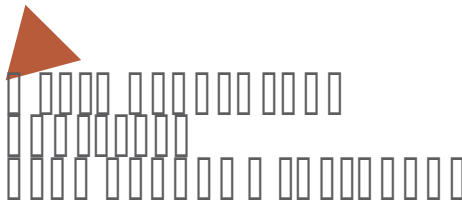

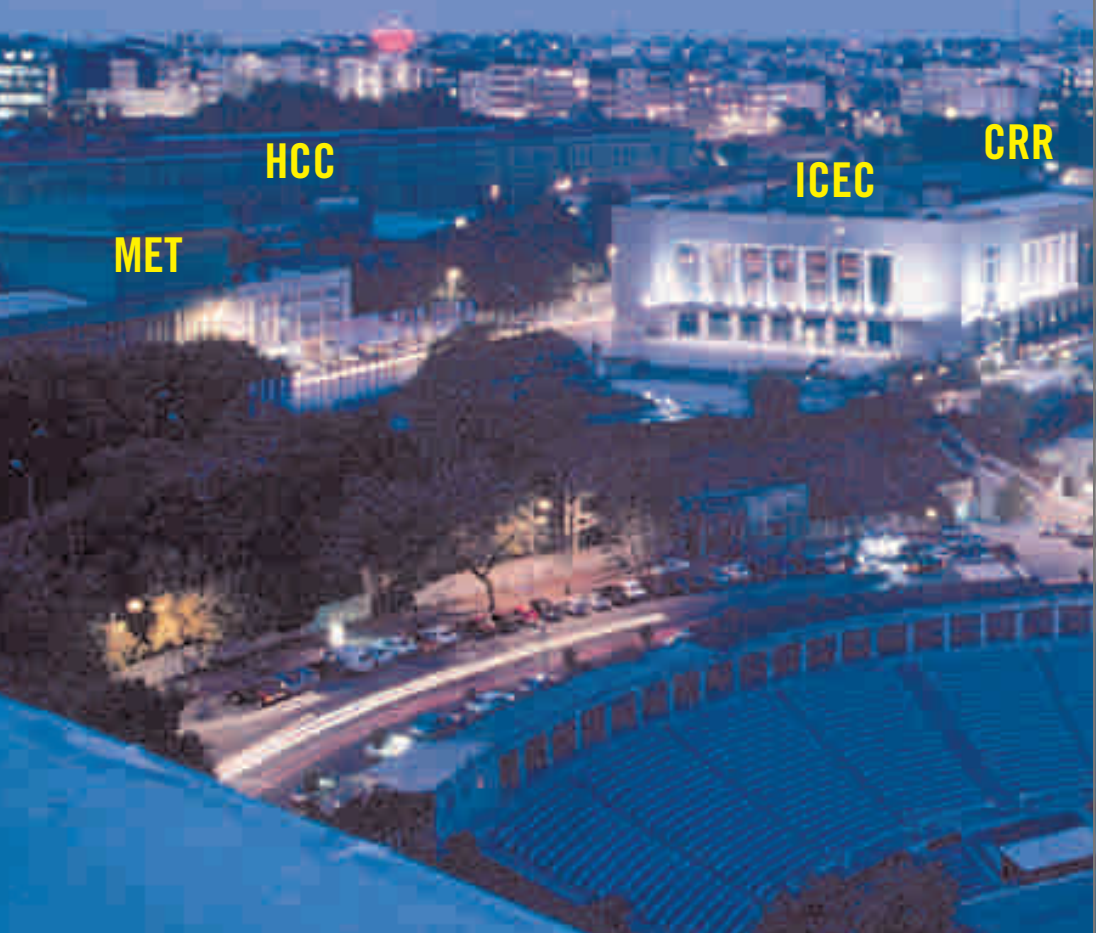
## CONFERENCE VENUE
