GEORGE BAIRD, RAIC GOLD MEDAL

Architect, architectural critic, teacher and author, George Baird graduated from the University of Toronto's school of architecture in 1962. The Baird, Sampson, Neuert agency, of which he is an associate, has won numerous prizes. George Baird served as dean of the faculty of architecture, landscape architecture and design at the University of Toronto, where he was also a professor. He has authored a number of works, among them the critically acclaimed 'The space of appearance'.

According to the Gold Medal jury: *for decades he was the mentor of some of Canada's most eminent architects and professors. As a theorist, urban planner or competition consultant, George Baird played an essential role where the Canadian city is at its most complex.*

The gold medal will be official presented to him during the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada's Festival of Architecture, that will take place on **22 to 26 June 2010**.
