The Peak International Architectural Competition Jurors' Report

In reaching a majority decision the undersigned members of the Jury for The Peak Competition Hong Kong were mindful of the turmoil in architectural thought at this time. The Jury put great faith in the competition system - the one forum through which all architects have the opportunity to reach beyond the norm and be recognised.

Entry No. 129 was unique among 539 entries received. This entry, at a time of highly referenced architectural thinking, Often reaching back into antiquity, has as its reference the 1920 Suprematist philosophy and stretches the imagination well beyond normal bounds.

Inspite of a certain lack of resolution in some areas the project accepted the challenge of a competition, concentrating energies on exploration of ideas as apposed to resolution of detail, an approach common to many other entries. The sculptural nature of this solution promises to extend the imagination and symbolise the essence of a new building type in a unique location.

This decision was not unanimous and represented many hours of deliberation and strong expression of personal feelings. The debate, quite simply, explored the question of a selection based on demonstrable competence or the acknowledgement of a brilliant idea with full competency obviously possible, but yet to be demonstrated.

In general the quality of entries was not up to expectation, most architects slavishly following the brief without questioning and as a result an alarmingly uniform range of solutions were presented.

We believe this attitude to be unfortunate and it can in no way further the profession of architecture.

The Jury wish to acknowledge the efforts of Jon Prescott, Margaret Huffadine and their staff and applaud their professionalism in conducting the competition. We look forward to the success of the project.
