BUILDING COMMUNITY

The Festa dell'Architetto is an opportunity to reaffirm the commitment of a professional category serving the community by contributing to the discussion of issues that are fundamental to its future.

In the previous editions, we explored the theme of shared spaces, of necessary interventions in our cities and lifestyles for the survival of the planet, and we questioned ourselves about what skills were needed to face the social and climate changes currently occurring. Last year, we focused on the delicate relationship between the human and the urban, and on the need for our profession to take an approach that makes cities better places to live, emphasizing how skills, abilities, political will, and appropriate regulations can contribute to the introduction of important and urgent changes across all territories.

Today, we reaffirm the need for urban regeneration approaches based on a vision that is more attentive to human needs, implemented and regulated correctly and consistently with social and environmental changes. We are aware that urban space either enables or denies better living conditions, guarantees or limits opportunities and social justice.

This topic is central to the political action of the National Council of Architects, Planners, Landscapers and Conservationists. On October 31st 2025, at Ca' Giustinian - headquarters of the La Biennale di Venezia - the discussion will focus on the benefits that major international urban transformation experiences have brought to people's lives.

Together with renowned experts, we will evaluate the outcomes obtained in those territories where policies and laws related to architecture guide collective action.

We will once again strongly reiterate the need for a Law on Architecture and Landscape, which is not a law for a professional category, but for citizens — people of a nation among the richest in architectural and urban stratification in the world. Finally, we will award the regeneration projects by italian designers who, with courage, submitted their work to the judgment of others, thereby contributing to the enrichment of Italy's design heritage.
